Ontario County firm could add 75 jobs

Rochester Insulated Glass, a manufacturer of insulated and heat-treated glass, says it will invest \$8.65 million in a 70,000-square-foot expansion of its facility in Manchester, Ontario County.

The expansion would give the company space to create a new product line and enable it to add about 75 jobs over three years. The company now has 62 employees.

Empire State Development Corp., Rochester Gas and Electric, and the Finger Lakes WIRED (Workforce Innovation in Regional Economic Development) initiative are making incentives or grants available to Rochester Insulated Glass.
